
Beginning on Monday, May 18th, we made arrangements for students to come to DHS to pick up personal belongings left in their locker and gym locker, return textbooks, athletic uniforms and equipment, and other items. Seniors will also have opportunity to return their MacBooks. Students should bring a bag to remove all contents from their lockers.

Schedule

We are following a specific alphabetical schedule to allow students into the building, while maintaining required health precautions and social distancing. The schedule is below and runs from Monday, May 18th through Wednesday, May 20th. *Only DHS staff and students will be allowed into the building.* In order to comply with state and county guidelines and avoid long lines or students congregating, students will be allowed entry to DHS during their designated time, with a maximum of 30 students being allowed into the building at a given time.

School Entry/Exit

Students must enter the north student entrance doors, where there will be designated spots on the sidewalk and inside the building to ensure appropriate social distancing. If 30 students are in the building already, then students will be asked to wait in line and stand in the designated spots outside. For this reason, it is important that students quickly and efficiently move through the building and not congregate. Students will exit at the media center and parents can pick them up outside that exit. See the map below for details.



Inside Locations

Students are only allowed to be in the following areas of the building. Once students proceed to the media center to check-in materials, they are to exit the building.

- Commons: Athletic uniforms, Choir, Art, FACS pick-up/drop-off materials, and Senior MacBook Check-In
- Band Room: drop-off materials
- Drama Room/Theater: pick-up/drop-off materials
- PE Locker Rooms: clean-out gym locker
 Media Center: Textbook Check-In EXIT
