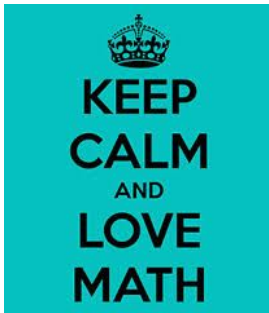
## ELA/Social Studies

With our State Testing now behind us, we will begin working on our 4th quarter narrative writing assignment. We will also continue reviewing Language (grammar).

This is the final week the kids will have weekly words. This week students will be tested on the prefix "dis." Each week, students can study by logging into [quizlet.com](http://quizlet.com). This website creates online flashcards, a matching game, and other ways for your child to study.

**Social Studies** - We will be getting most of our reading and text analysis through "The Road to the American Revolution" and as well the "American Revolution" units. Students will be learning about the causes that lead up to the revolution and how and why it happened. These two units will take us until the second to last week in school.

Our next major project will be our toothpick bridge project. This will begin in mid-May. It will satisfy the STEM component of our science curriculum.



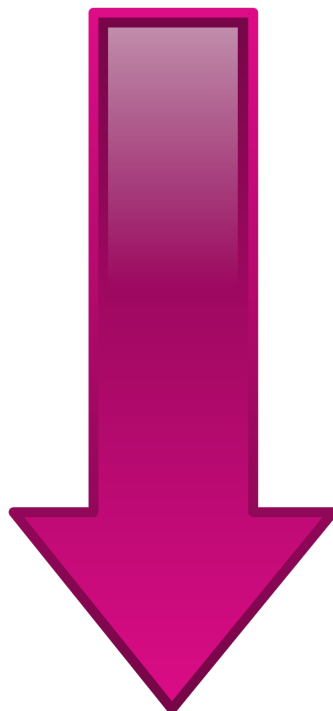
