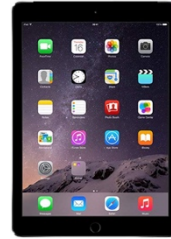







# Using the iPad Camera to Make a Digital Worksheet



1. Take a picture of the paper worksheet with your iPad Camera
2. Go to Photos and select the photo you want.
3. Tap **Edit**, tap , then tap **Markup** . Tap the **plus button**  and select the **Text** and **Edit** to add text, use speech dictation (choose microphone in keyboard), add shapes or highlight. 
4. Tap **Done**, then tap **Done** again.
5. Click the **send**  button to email or airdrop the worksheet to turn it in.

## Who and Why?

1. Reluctant writers and students who get bogged down by spelling can work with much more independence and less frustration.
2. Students can often keep pace with their peers or stay in the classroom using this tool.
3. Students with executive function challenges can complete work without any lost papers or assignments completed but not turned in.
4. Many students can produce more language verbally when you take the motor task of writing out of the mix.
5. Students whose frustration with the writing process causes dysregulation or behavior can avoid problems.
6. Independence and success breed self-confident learners
