## **Pre ACT 9&10 Scores:**

PreACT student score reports and testing booklets will be distributed during Seminar this Thursday, November 17. The PreACT9 takes the number of questions you got correct on each test and translates in into a number between 1-30, which is also called a scale score. The scores show how well you did on each test. The PreACT10 is very similar however, the scale score is between 1-35. Although the tests have different ranges, the student score report provides ideas for how to progress and improve your score. Both assessments measure your college readiness skills and can be used to predict how you are likely to do when you take the ACT as an 11<sup>th</sup> grader. The scores are only an estimate. Please see the attached documents which help you understand your assessment results. There is also a student sample report which explains each category.
