The boys team placed 6th with a team score of 2642 (3490 with 4 baker games). Senior Brett Stockwell placed 18th overall as an individual with a 651 series. Senior Ethan Diehl placed 13th with a 670 series. Senior Andrew Kouris placed 2nd with a 725 series.
