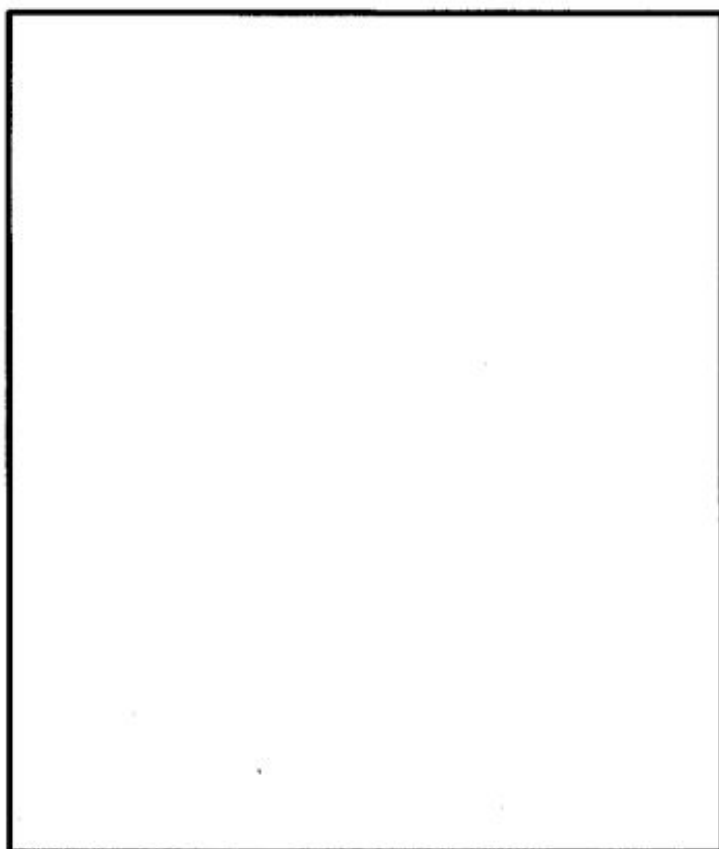

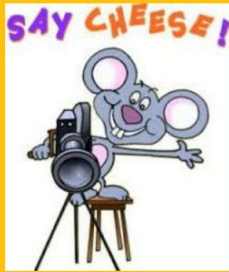

### Seasonal Allergies
