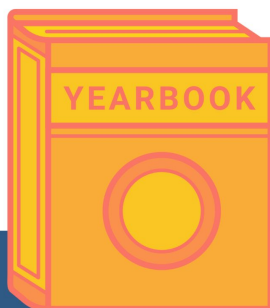
From The Library:

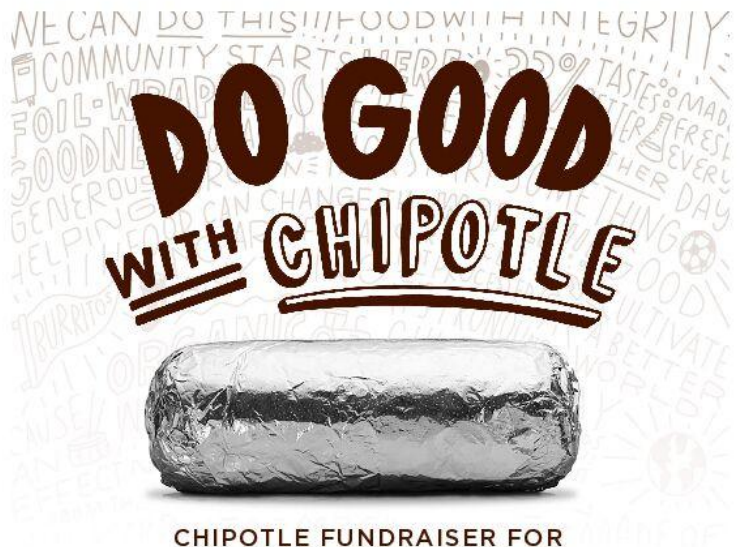
