From the MC Nurse's Office

Dear Mill Creek Family,

The transition to ever changing autumn weather often comes hand-in-hand with cold and allergy season, but healthy habits can help protect everyone from getting or spreading germs. As we enter fall season, we appreciate you encouraging these healthy habits with your children. You are receiving this message as your student was confirmed or presumed absent today related to an illness.

If you have a child who is sick, we ask for your support by keeping them at home. Students and staff must be <u>fever-free for 24 hours</u> without the use of medication, and free of vomiting and/or diarrhea for 24 hours before returning to school. We strongly encourage seeing a healthcare provider if symptoms last longer than 48 hours. Please be mindful of the common cold, flu, strep throat and COVID. If your student is <u>diagnosed</u> with Influenza ("the Flu") or with COVID, they must remain at home for 5 days from the onset of illness, with return on day 6. Please let your nurse know if your student has been diagnosed.

If you have questions about your student's health, please contact your school nurse. Additional information regarding health and wellness is available on the district website. Remind your child of important preventative measures for any illness, such as coughing into the sleeve, frequently washing hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds and getting plenty of rest and fluids. As you know, the health and safety of our students and staff is a top priority. Our school staff will continue to stress preventative measures, and our custodial staff will continue to follow appropriate cleaning procedures to ensure common areas shared by students and points of high contact are disinfected.
