

National Suicide Prevention Week is Sept 10 - Sept 16. According to the CDC, in 2021 suicide was the second leading cause of death among individuals between the ages of 10-14. Last year, the new national suicide and crisis lifeline was launched. Call or text 988 to be connected with confidential support for anyone in suicidal crisis or emotional distress. This can be accessed via call or text 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.


From the MC Nurse's Office

Health Screening

As part of DeSoto 232 School District's health program, the school nurse will do a hearing and vision screening on your child during the 2023-2024 school year. Vision screenings are performed periodically to identify those students who may have a vision disorder in need of attention. Vision screening do not replace a complete vision exam conducted by an eye care professional (optometrist or ophthalmologist). A hearing screen is done to try and determine if your child is hearing at his/her best which is crucial to their learning in the classroom. A hearing screen does not replace an exam conducted by an ENT physician or audiologist.

All students will bring home their printed health screening results. The school nurse will screen your student unless heard from you stating otherwise. If you wish for your student to opt out of their health screenings, please email your MCMS nurses at MCMSNurses@usd232.org.
