



Indoor Rentals COVID-19 Protocol

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, USD232 is committed to taking the necessary precautions to help maintain the health and safety of our community. Following guidance from the CDC, KDHE, KSHSAA, county and city governing bodies, USD 232 implemented the following safeguards:

- Individuals will NOT be allowed to attend any events if exposed to COVID-19 in the prior 14 days or under a 14-day quarantine or isolation.
- If an individual has been exposed or under a 14-day quarantine, the individual must have medical clearance prior to attending events on USD 232 property.
- Attendance should be taken for individuals attending every event.
- All individuals over five years of age will wear face coverings appropriately and at all times.
- If speakers/presenters are not wearing masks, they should be at least six feet, and ten feet if possible, from other individuals.
- If singers are not wearing a mask, they should be at least 15 feet from other individuals if possible.
- If woodwind, brass or similar instruments are used, the musicians should be at least six feet apart and bell covers should be used.
- Plan events to maintain social distancing guidelines by family unit whenever possible.
- If non-family groups need to be within six feet of each other, consider using “pods” of the same individuals.
- Participants should wash hands or use hand sanitizer before and after the event.
- Once the event is over, participants will be required to immediately leave and not congregate.

Groups that do not follow the COVID-19 Protocols may not be allowed to rent USD 232 facilities in the future. This includes events that are already scheduled.
