Indoor Sports Rentals COVID-19 Protocol

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, USD232 is committed to taking the necessary precautions to help maintain the safety of our student-athlete population, coaching staffs, support personnel, and visitors. Following guidance from the CDC, KDHE, KSHSAA, county and city governing bodies, USD 232 implemented the following safeguards:

- Student(s) and/or Coaches will NOT be allowed to attend practice or games if exposed to COVID-19 in the prior 14 days or under a 14-day quarantine or isolation.
- If student or coach has been exposed or under a 14-day quarantine, the student/coach must have medical clearance prior to returning to practice or games.
- Attendance of athletes and coaches should be recorded for each event/practice.
- Student-athletes should provide their own water bottles.
- Student athletes as well as Coaching/support staff will wear face coverings appropriately and at all times.
- Adult athletes will wear face coverings at all times except when actively participating in competition.
- Once the practice or game is over, students will be required to immediately leave and not congregate.
- Players and team personnel on the team bench will practice social distancing and wear masks at all times.
- Plan practices to maintain social distancing guidelines whenever possible.
- Consider having workouts in “pods” of the same students using the same balls.
- Players should wash hands or use hand sanitizer before and after practices

Spectators

- Spectators are not allowed to attend events if they are under a COVID-19 quarantine or isolation.
- Spectators, upon entering the facility, must wear a mask or face covering at all times.
- Social distancing by household groups is required with a minimum of six feet between groups.
- Tickets must be presold. No tickets sales at the door.
- The number of spectators is limited to two (2) tickets per participant.
- Spectators will not be allowed near participants. All spectators must remain off competition courts. ONLY essential personnel will be allowed near participants.

- All spectator guidelines are subject to change based on local guidelines and conditions.
- All spectators are expected to cooperate with ALL guidelines, as this will help us continue to have spectators at events.
- Bleachers have been marked to assist with appropriate social distance.
- There are rows of bleachers marked “Please DO Not Use this Row”.
- Concessions are not allowed as part of the event.
- Spectators will need to exit the building when their participant’s game/activity has concluded.
- Failure to comply with spectator guidelines will result in being asked to leave without refund.

Groups that do not follow the COVID-19 Protocols may not be allowed to rent USD 232 facilities in the future. This includes events that are already scheduled.
