Requirements:

1. Students must be 14 years of age by January 1, 2020
2. Students must obtain an IP, {Instructional Permit}, from a Kansas Driver's License Station. **Bring your IP and a copy of your US birth certificate or US Passport to the first session of the driver education class.** This is necessary to properly fill out the DE – 99 Form.
3. Students taking driver education this semester must complete the Student Enrollment Form. It can be obtained at the school office and on our website. <https://ks02213215.schoolwires.net/Domain/3753>
4. Students must attend all class sessions unless excused by the instructor. All absences will be made up.

Description:

Driver Education is an adult course offered by the school district to enable students to learn the basics of driving in all kinds of traffic situations. Because of the nature of the course students will be treated like adults and therefore need to remember to act in an appropriate adult manor. The course will consist of lecture, videos, guest speakers, written work assigned text readings, behind the wheel driving, and tests. The final test must be passed at 90% or better. Actual driving time will be scheduled with the instructor. Students will be scheduled in groups of two or three and will drive at least 2 times, or more if needed to evaluate the student's progress.

- In order to receive a **restricted license**, you must be 15 years of age and wait until your IP is at least one-year-old and you have driven at least 25 hours with your parents. Also, you must have a Driver Education Completion Certificate.
- In order to receive a **driver's license**, you must be at least 16 years of age and wait until your IP is one-year-old and you have driven at least 50 hours with your parents.
- Students may take Driver Education in order to learn how to drive and receive ¼ of a credit. It is not necessary to get any license to pass the course. However, you must obtain an Instructional Permit (IP) from the State of Kansas.
